Measure 3: Candidate Competency at Program Completion

Wayne State University initial licensure completers must pass state-required Michigan Test for Teacher Certification (MTTC) certification exams. The purpose of the tests is to ensure that each certified teacher has the necessary professional readiness and content knowledge to serve in Michigan schools.

Data from the MTTC exam are aligned to individual program content standards within the individual WSU Teacher Education program reports. Data are disaggregated annually by the program and shared with program coordinators. Program coordinators use this data to prepare the annual program reports, which monitor program completer progress on WSU Teacher Education program standards.
